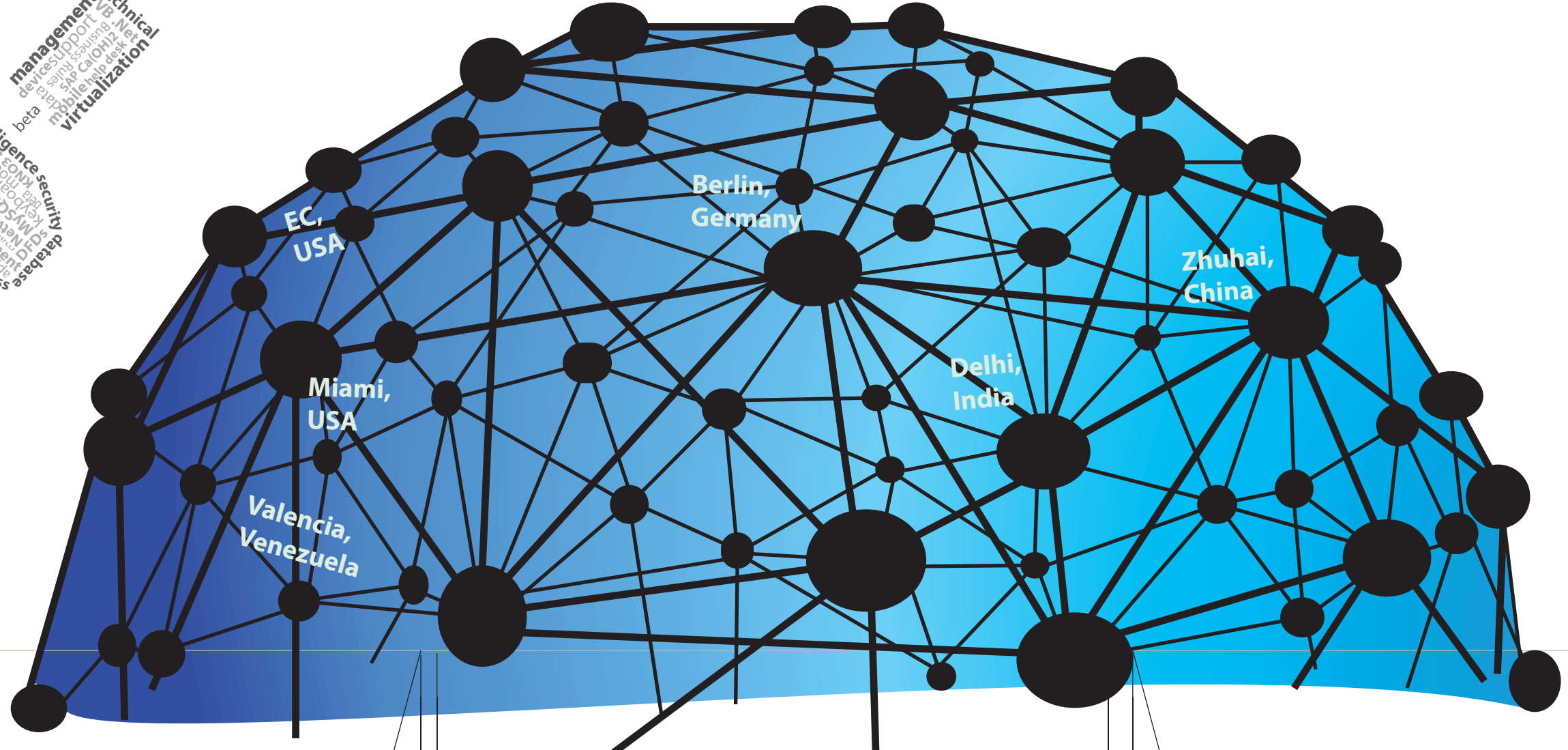
About Me

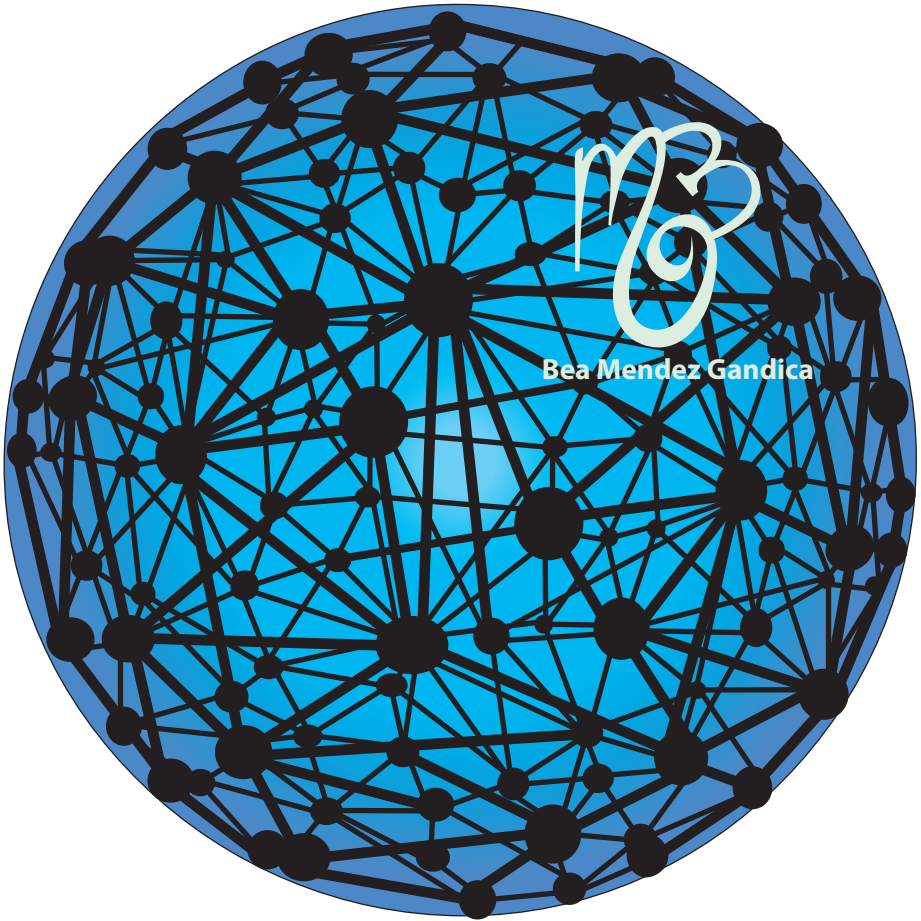
